Sometimes I am asked the question of "why?" "Why did God give me a child with cancer, M.S., C.P., etc?" If He promised me an abundant life, than He must obviously be a God who doesn't keep His promises. I immediately ask myself, "Doesn't God love me anymore?"

First, God does love you. He loves you with a love that passes all human understanding. He loves with a sacrificial love. That sacrificial love being His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ.

Secondly, God does not bring evil or sorrow to His creation; for this would be out of His character. God does, however, permit evil and sorrow to test and try His SPECIAL creation...YOU!

God's Word tells us that we are created in His image and likeness, and that He breathed into mankind the breath of life. As a result, we became a living soul, a special creation. We were created a little lower than the angels themselves, but given a crown of honor and glory (Hebrews 2:7).
