Impacting Difference

Have you ever tried to evangelize to someone? I recently joined an evangelism team at my church, and it has been interesting to hear others' views on evangelism. There is often the tactic of asking someone where they will go when they die. Or people will go right in and start sharing the Gospel with lots of terms like propitiation, repentance, and atonement. But, when it comes to sharing the Truth with people with disabilities it looks a lot different.

This year marks my 5th year working full-time at H*VMI and my 11th year serving with Handi*Camp. In all my years with H*VMI, I always recognized that what we did was different. Not every ministry serves people with disabilities. Not every ministry can care for those with extensive medical and/or behavioral challenges. Not every church can care for those with disabilities in their congregation. But, I recently met with a local woman who was looking for how to better serve a young girl with disabilities at church and her comment really struck me...

"Talking with a mom of a child with disabilities, I was reminded that they need the Gospel shared with them just as much as anyone else. I had never thought about that. We were at church. I just assumed she had heard the Gospel." - Church buddy looking for training



Her comment helped me to realize that the things mentioned above are not what make us different. What makes us different is the Gospel and how we are able to make it accessible to those we serve. Going to camp, going to church, living in a Christian home are all great things, but none of those things will get those we serve to Heaven. At H*VMI, I am able to share the Good News of the Gospel with those who might not ever hear it in a way they can understand.

We might not dress in fancy clothes, sing like a choir, or sit still for 30+ minutes, but we are able to be the church for a large group of people who may never make it through those doors on a Sunday morning. Praise God that His Word is accessible for ALL!
