## **Parents Share**



It seemed impossible that after all we had been through, things would end as they did—with Trisha's death. Fourteen months of treatment for leukemia, bone marrow transplant and it seemed a happy ending would be ours. Now I had to leave the hospital without her, my heart aching to hold her.

In subsequent days, while watching some Christian broadcasts, I heard stories and testimonies from parents, praising the Lord for miraculously restoring their children to health. It was almost too much to bear. I began to question my faith, or lack of it. Hadn't I believed enough that God would heal her? If not, was I then somehow responsible for her death?

As I thought on these things and about God's purpose, I felt the Lord's love for me and a sense of peace and an awareness that it was not the amount of faith, or the lack of it that determined whether Trisha lived or died. He could have healed her, regardless of me.

It's natural for parents whose children have been restored to praise Him. But for me, for other parents whom God has chosen to act otherwise, our praise to God would not be the result of a natural overflow of the heart. It would be the result of the supernatural power of God! It would be God's power at work in our lives bringing healing, restoring our joy and putting a song of thanksgiving in our hearts. The miracle He has done in our lives is worthy of our praise. It is every bit as much a miracle as raising a child from a death bed.

Each day that passes brings us one day closer to reunion with her and with our Savior.
